Herewith, please find all necessary details, as well as a list of important dates, for easy reference and to assist with planning.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The competition is open to pupils from Grades 3 to 7.
- The competition comprises of two rounds, followed by a prize giving for the top 100 achievers.
- Grade 3 pupils will write Level 0, Grade 4 and 5 pupils will write Level 1, and Grade 6 and 7 pupils will write Level 2.
- Please feel free to pass on this information to neighbouring schools who may not have been involved in Beyond Maths before.
- Should your school not wish to participate this year, kindly let us know via email as soon as possible, to avoid unnecessary communication.

- A teacher workshop will be hosted at Glenwood Prep on **Friday 14 March from 14:00 to 15:30 (International Day of Mathematics)**. 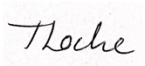
ROUND ONE

- Round One is free for all pupils. Schools are encouraged to allow all of their Grade 3 to 7 pupils to write.
- Schools are requested to return their Round One entry forms via email by **15 April 2025** to confirm participation for this year.
- The Round One question papers will be sent via email to participating schools by **2 June 2025**.
- Each school is responsible for photocopying the Round One papers for their pupils.
- The Round One test is to be written at individual schools between **9 and 13 June 2025**.
- All questions are worth 1 mark each. The first 15 questions will have multiple choice answers and the last 5 questions will require short answers. The test is out of 20 marks.
- Pupils must be encouraged to do working out on rough paper, but no calculators are permitted.
- The duration of the paper is one hour, with no time extensions.
- Answer papers must be marked by the teachers at the school. The memo will be supplied.

ROUND TWO

- Pupils who achieve 50% and above (i.e. 10 and over) qualify to participate in Round Two.
- The cost per pupil to participate in Round Two is R20.
- Schools must submit their Round Two entry forms (names must be typed please), with pupils' Round One scores and proof of payment, by **31 July 2025**.

- Round Two will comprise of 15 questions (5 multiple choice questions; 5 short answers; 5 full-working answers).
- Round Two will be written at Glenwood Preparatory School on **Friday 29 August and Saturday 30 August 2025**. Different grades/levels will write over these two days. Times will be confirmed.
- Results will be finalised by **9 September 2025** and details will be sent to schools regarding the Prize Giving.
- Prize Giving is scheduled for **Saturday 20 September 2025** (arrival from 13:30 to start at 14:00).
- Certificates, badges, prizes and trophies will be awarded to our top achievers.

We look forward to another successful year of promoting problem-solving and a passion for Mathematics in our KZN pupils and teachers.



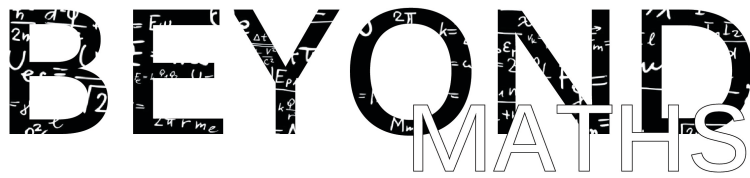

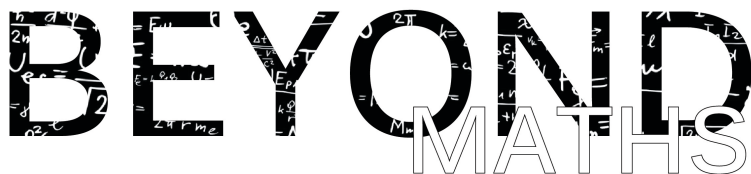
